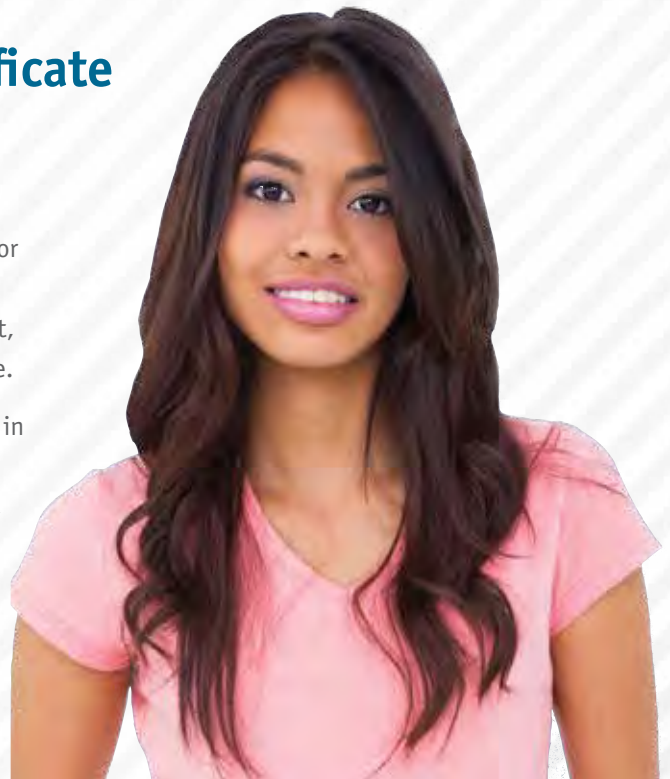
**Want guaranteed transfer to
