

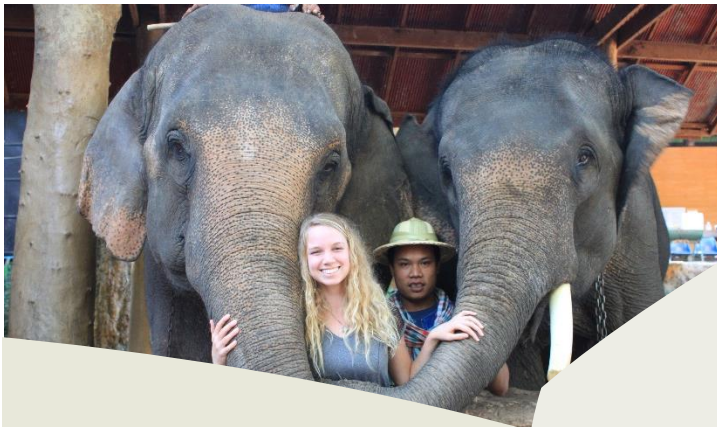
Study Abroad in Thailand



Attention Students:

Travel to Thailand, 2 Weeks in January, 2018

The program is designed to expose students to Thailand's long history and vibrant culture. In addition, the program will include an emphasis on the Hmong migration from Laos to the United States. The journey will begin in Bangkok, Thailand's capital, and head north into the more traditional heartland of Thailand. Participants will have the chance to engage with Thai students and faculty, explore businesses, and see both cultural sites and historical monuments. Day trips will explore floating markets, royal palaces, an elephant park, tribal villages, and much more.



- **Estimated program cost: \$3,000 (includes flight, lodging, & some meals)**
 - Costs do not include tuition, recommended vaccinations, passport and some meals

- Applicants will be notified via email if they are selected for the program and if they have been awarded the grant on **September 20th, 2017**
- Students secure their participation in the program by submitting their first payment. Payment details below.
- Participants are required to attend a pre-departure orientation. The orientation will be scheduled on a Saturday in October or November.

- 1st Payment of \$600, due September 22nd (cannot apply the International Grant to the first two payments)
 - 2nd Payment of \$600, due September 29th (cannot apply the International Grant to the first two payments)
 - 3rd Payment of \$600, due October 27th
 - 4th Payment of \$600 due November 17th
 - 5th and final payment of \$600 due December 15th
- The study abroad payments do not include: tuition (optional), passport, some meals, and recommended vaccinations.
