## London, Amsterdam, & The Hague

### Travel 2-weeks in January 2018

Students will travel to London, The Hague and Amsterdam in this exciting experience for law, business, and trades and engineering technology students. While in London, students will tour courts and other legal institutions to compare American and British legal systems. Students will also visit London's major landmarks, including the Tower of London, London Eye and Westminster Abbey while also learning about the local architecture. In The Hague students will learn about international human rights at the International Criminal Court and tour international businesses. In Amsterdam, students will visit the Anne Frank House and stroll through the canal district.
