For centuries, Belizean communities have been practicing sustainability. Much of the country's electricity is provided by renewables including hydroelectric dams and sugar bagasse bioenergy. Students will experience farming and energy practices used in rural villages, study the impact of global warming on the coral reef, and explore a Mayan herbal and medicine garden.

- **Early bird applications are due May 5th, 2017**. Applications will be reviewed the following week and accepted students will be asked to make a \$350 payment by Friday, May 17th to secure their spot on the program

- Applicants will be notified via email if they are selected for the program and if they have been awarded the grant by **September 20th, 2017**
- Students secure their participation in the program by submitting their first payment. Payment details below
- Participants are required to attend pre-departure meetings, starting in October

- 1st Payment of \$600, due September 22nd (cannot apply the International Grant to the first two payments)
 - 2nd Payment of \$600, due September 29th (cannot apply the International Grant to the first two payments)
 - 3rd Payment of \$600, due October 27th
 - 4th Payment of \$600 due November 17th
 - 5th and final payment of \$300 due December 15th
- The study abroad payments do not include: passport fees, tuition, some meals, and recommended vaccinations.
